



Loading Korg MP-10 PRO's Operating System

From time to time, Korg could release a new version of the operating system, that can be freely downloaded from one of our web sites. Here is how to load it into your MP-10 PRO.

1. Copy the “mp_os.pkg” operating system file into the root of an USB storage device.
2. If it is on, turn the MP-10 PRO off. Then keep the PAD A button pressed, and turn the MP-10 PRO on again.
3. Keep the PAD A button pressed, until the Touch Panel Calibration page appears: this confirms the system loading procedure has been started. Execute the display calibration, and confirm.
4. A message appears, asking you to connect the USB device containing the operating system.



5. Connect the USB storage device to the HOST USB 1 port. When the device has been connected, touch the OK button to confirm

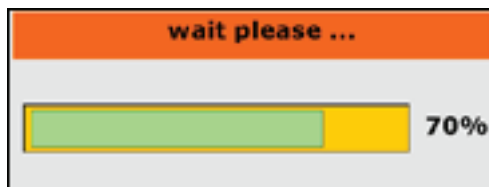
Note: In case the operating system file is not found in the USB device, the “Package not found” dialog box appears, warning you of the missing file. Touch the OK button to close the dialog box.



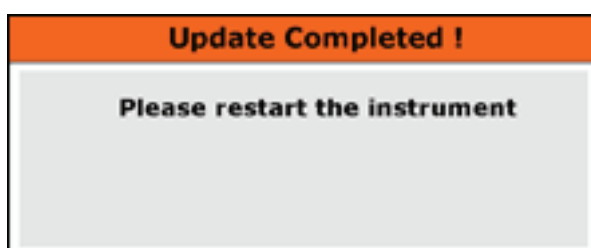
6. The “Wait Please” message appears while the operating system file is being loaded.



The HD indicator starts flashing, then a progress bar appears, showing the loading status.



7. When the loading procedure is finished, the “Update Completed!” message appears, inviting you to re-start the instrument.



8. Turn the MP-10 PRO off, then on again.
